Child and Family Services of Western Manitoba is seeking mature individuals to work with a sixteen year-old autistic adolescent within in his residence in Brandon.

We are specifically seeking applicants who are available to work the evening shift on weekdays (3pm to 11pm) and the morning/evening shift on weekends (7am to 3pm or 3pm to 11pm). Successful applicants must be available to pick up weekend shifts at least two weekends per month. The positions are considered casual; however, staff are permitted to work up to 40 hours per week, depending on availability.

Duties include but are not limited to: interacting with energetic resident, resident self-care and proper hygiene maintenance, household duties such as cooking and cleaning, and driving the youth to and from appointments. Experience working with individuals with autism spectrum disorder is a definite asset.

- At least one year of post secondary education is preferred;
- Experience working with autism spectrum disorder is a definite asset;
- Experience with children and adolescents;
- Excellent organizational and communication skills;
