Shifts include various daytime, evening and/or awake night hours. Duties include but are not limited to: standard youth care responsibilities, participation in staff meetings, report writing, driving youth to appointments and school, and household maintenance tasks. Applicants without at least one year of post-secondary education are only permitted to pick-up night shifts. Wage scale is \$13.08 to \$14.32 per hour.

Please note: Patrick House and Cypress House are licensed congregate care facilities through the Province of Manitoba. As a result, all employees fall under the Province's mandatory full vaccination or regular Covid-19 testing plan beyond October 18, 2021.

Qualifications:

- At least one full year of post-secondary education preferred;
- Related experience working with youth is considered a definite asset;
- Valid Manitoba Class 5F Driver's licence;
- Standard First Aid & CPR level A;
- Must be legally entitled to work in Canada;
- Successful completion of a Criminal Record check, a Child Abuse Registry check, a Prior Contact check and a Driver's Abstract check is required.
